# **NOTES:**

### • English:

- This comprises the study of AS English Language and is compulsory for all L6 students.
- Students who do not attain a pass at IGCSE English Language will be placed in a support class with the aim to rewrite the subject at IGCSE Level at the end of L6. This class will follow a one-year revision syllabus which all students must commit to.

# • Subject Choices:

- From the remaining four Blocks (B to E), students must choose a minimum of three subjects. Four subjects are permissible, but students are advised to consider the considerable additional workload this will incur.

### Mathematics:

- AS or AS Level Mathematics may be studied only with the approval of the Head of Mathematics, who will vet all prospective students and make a final decision based on ability and a track record of work ethic.
- Extended IGCSE Mathematics with an A or a B grade is a requirement to study full A Level Mathematics.
- Students with a C grade in IGCSE Mathematics may be admitted to AS Mathematics studied over 2 years at the discretion of the Head of Mathematics.

# • Full A Level subjects:

- An A\*, A or B grade at IGCSE must be attained in order to be eligible to study that subject to full A Level.
- Heads of Departments reserve the right to decline a student admission into their subject if they have not established a sound work-ethic in Form Four.

#### • AS over two years:

- These are studied to AS Level over two years and do not include the study of the A2 Level syllabuses.

# French/Mandarin

- French and Mandarin may be studied by special arrangement with the College but only if there is sufficient interest. Please indicate a desire to do so.

#### • Viability:

- All subjects offered are dependent on minimum numbers needed to make the subject viable.
- In instances where subjects do not prove viable, students will be asked to select alternatives.

#### **6<sup>TH</sup> FORM TUTORING**

Tuition periods are provided in the timetable for all students to seek additional academic support from their teachers or other members of departments in all 6<sup>th</sup> Form subjects offered.

# DA VINCI 6<sup>TH</sup> FORM

With the assistance of the Da Vinci Centre, support is offered to all students who wish to achieve a benchmark of attaining five quality IGCSE subjects (including passes in English Language and Mathematics). This option could be pursued by students who would otherwise struggle to meet the criteria for studying a full menu of A Level subjects. The subjects chosen will require approval from the Academic Head of 6<sup>th</sup> Form and will depend on availability of staff and resources.

In addition, students can opt for one or two AS Level or A Level subjects to be studied over two years.

In certain cases, options for study can be tailored towards a student's interests and intended future career paths. Please feel free to discuss these options. Again, this will depend on the availability of staff and resources.

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
