Jersey:	Grey with green stripe in the neck (anytime)	
Cap:	Bottle green with strapping at the back	
Hat:	Emerald broad-brimmed

Winter:	Light grey shirts can be worn with grey trouser	

Number Ones

A number of issues have been identified by parents, students, and faculty members over the course of the previous and current school years all related to the uniform. Of major concern have been the myriad shades, in particular blazers, grey longs, tracksuits, caps and College grey T-shirts that have filtered into our uniform over the years. Secondly, the branding of the St John's uniform had been compromised by rogue companies producing the uniform without our approval and according to specific standards. The objective of this policy is to restore the quality and shade of the College uniform to its original colour and the correct branding by streamlining our stockists and manufacturers.
